Dear Dr. Eisner,

I have made enquiries about the matters regarding which you spoke to me on Thursday, and regret to inform you that it is not possible for you to obtain permission to go aboard the ship carrying the illegal immigrants, for the purpose of a short visit to your mother.

As regards the question of sending articles to her on the ship I am told that certain arrangements have been made by which foodstuffs (in addition to the fruit which you mentioned to me) can be sent on board. For details of these arrangements, as well as for your request to send blankets or clothing to your mother, you should apply directly to Police headquarters, C.I.D. branch.
