

I was born on April 21, 1909 in GUTTENTAG, Oberschlesien (Upper Silesia)

My father: L u d w i g E i s n e r , born November 27, 1880, also in G. ¹⁸⁵²

My mother: R o s a E i s n e r (family name: HEIMANN), born August 30, 1884 in TARNOWITZ, Upper Silesia. ¹⁸⁵¹

Note: At that time both Guttentag and Tarnowitz belonged to Germany. Today they belong to Poland.

My parents: married August 12, 1906 and lived from that date until 1938 in G.

My sister: Alice M e y e r s t e i n , born June 29, 1910 in G., married in 1932 the advocate Ludwig M. and lived until 1939 in HALLE (Germany). Since then they live in BEDFORD, England. Their only child, John M. lives in Canada. He married a Christian. His two daughters are Christians.

Grandfather: born about 1855 in KLOBOTZ (a village near the famous Polish town of Adolf CZENSTOCHOVA) came as a very young man to G. in order not to become a Russian soldier. (Poland was at that time a part of Russia). He became a master-baker and married my E i s n e r

Grandmother: ~~born~~ Born in 1856 in G. Her family name was GROSS. They had six children, one Fanny of them was my father. E i s n e r ¹⁸⁵⁶

Grandfather: Joseph H e i m a n n (my mother's father) was born about 1855 in a small village near TARNOWITZ. He was a merchant who had a small shop.

Grandmother: Regina H e i m a n n (family name BOEHM) born about 1855 in a village near LUBLINITZ, Upper Silesia.

Note: My paternal grandmother (Fanny), and my maternal grandparents come all from the same district (Upper Silesia) in Germany, while my paternal grandfather (Adolf) came from Poland.

Note: My grandmother Fanny, my father Ludwig and myself are all born in GUTTENTAG. Probably also my grandmother's mother (family name: FRIEDLAENDER.) My great-grandparents (parents of my grandmother Fanny) are buried in the Jewish cemetery in G.

About myself: After my matriculation ~~in~~ studied the law in Germany which I left because of the Nazis in summer 1939. I stayed in England until I got my permission to what was then PALESTINE. I arrived here in January 1940 and live since then in Jerusalem. In 1942 I married Lea Spiegelman, born 1908 in Bendzin, Poland.
